



Modified Charge of the Ozone Transport Commission to the Stationary and Area Source Committee Regarding Electric Generating Units

The Commission directs the Stationary and Area Source Committee and the applicable workgroups to continue their work on Electric Generating Unit (EGU) emission reduction strategies and the structures necessary to incorporate "CAIR Plus" and High Energy Demand Day (HEDD) emission reduction strategies into State Implementation Planning for ozone attainment.

The recommendation(s) should consider regional implementation through state collaboration and other measures provided for through the Clean Air Act to implement this program over the broadest region appropriate.

The Commission directs this work be completed by January 31, 2007 for action by the Commission at a special meeting to be held in February, 2007
