









20% Most Impaired Day Analysis:

Base Year (2000-2004) vs. Current (2017 -2021)







EPA Findings of Failure to Submit 2nd Planning Period Regional Haze SIPs

- Posted in FR on August 30, 2022 (87 FR 52856)
- Effective September 29, 2022
- 15 states (including four MANEVU states)
- Two years until FIP unless state submits, and EPA approves, SIP
- EPA committed to working with affected states
