### **Multi-Year Charge to the MANEVU Technical Support Committee (TSC)**

The TSC is charged with providing regular updates to the Air Directors and reporting at the June 2027 Meeting on the following activities:

- Monitor annual visibility trends, including those that will be needed for 3<sup>rd</sup> Regional Haze Planning Period SIPs (due in 2031);
- Coordinate among MANEVU member organizations, and other Regional Haze Planning Organizations as necessary, on the following:
  - Reviewing proposed EPA revisions to the Regional Haze Rule, with a particular focus on their potential effects on MANEVU and its Class I areas, and providing comment as necessary,
  - Facilitating consistency in modeling and other analysis techniques for determining which states contribute to visibility impairment at Class I areas,
  - Planning efforts for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Regional Haze Planning Period SIPs due in 2031, including the development of templates and other materials to encourage consistency in SIP and progress report submittal format;
- In conjunction with other Regional Haze Planning Organizations where feasible and appropriate, develop the training materials that will be needed for implementing regional haze rule requirements and for drafting approvable regional haze SIPs for the 3<sup>rd</sup> regional haze planning period; and
- Cooperatively leverage resources and activities with OTC and Northeast States for Coordinated Air Use Management (NESCAUM) on scientific techniques to assess measured and modeled visibility impairment levels and to evaluate the haze and multi-pollutant benefits of potential emissions control programs

The TSC is directed to coordinate with the OTC committees, the Mid-Atlantic Regional Air Management Association (MARAMA), and NESCAUM, as necessary and appropriate, in carrying out this Charge.
