



Inter-RPO Coordination

- Inter-RPO coordination process established, WESTAR
- Priorities for RHR changes
- Planning for 3rd round SIPs
- 2022 Collaborative emissions modeling platform

OTC Collaboration

- Modeling
 - Determining state linkages for consultation
 - Establishing 2038 reasonable progress goals
 - Tagging modeling to better understand sector contribution?
- Ozone/haze co-benefits of control measures (e.g., LMWCs)
- Wood combustion contributions to haze

Summary

- TSC workplan activities proceeding well.
- Most MV agencies now have approved 2nd round SIPs.
- Many MV agencies have submitted their 2nd round PRs (or are close).
- 2023 Metrics show visibility improvement, but more work to be done.
- MV has had, and will continue, coordination with other RPOs:
 - o RHR rule,
 - o 3rd round SIP planning,
 - o Modeling.
- TSC has had, and will continue, collaboration with OTC:
 - Modeling,
 - o Control measure co-benefits,
 - Emissions sector contributions.
